Why has the state changed its coat of arms several times over the centuries? The coat of arms of Iceland features a crowned shield displaying the Icelandic flag. Each of the spirit animals is armed, emphasizing their primary purpose — to protect the territory of the state from external enemies. The griffin wields powerful claws and a beak, the bull has horns, and the mythical dragon has its mouth open with its tongue sticking out.
