How to create a «speaking coat of arms»? A coat of arms is considered «speaking» when the names of some of its elements — most often the main figure — and the name of its owner sound similar. In the center of the large coat of arms of Belgium, on a black field, there is an image of a golden lion standing on its hind legs with its tongue out. This is Leo Belgicus — the Belgian lion, formerly the heraldic symbol of the Duchy of Brabant. Special names have been devised to describe different types of heraldic lions (rampant, passant, dormant, sejant, leaping, resting, etc.). Which country's coat of arms does not have a lion?
