Thus, the straight wide cross (the so-called «St. George's Cross») is the symbol of England, whose patron saint is St. George. The white diagonal cross («St. Andrew's Cross») is the symbol of Scotland. Over the white diagonal cross was placed the symbol of Ireland — the red diagonal cross («St. Patrick's Cross,» the patron saint of Ireland). Why do some coats of arms change while others remain unchanged? The Royal coat of arms of the United Kingdom appears in two versions, one of which is used only in Scotland. The figures of the supporters of the shield have changed over the centuries. At different times the shield was supported by falcons, a white swan, the boar of King Richard III (1452—1485), the red Welsh dragon indicating the Celtic origin of the Tudor dynasty, and a silver hound of the County of Richmond. Since 1603, the shield has been supported by the crowned British lion and...
