For what reason might a country's government change its national emblem? The coat of arms of Indonesia is an image of the golden Garuda bird with a shield on its chest. In the first section of the shield is a silver field with a black bull's head, in the second — a tree with a green crown on a silver field, in the third — a golden rice shoot to the right of cotton on a silver field, in the fourth — a golden chain. Rice not only reflects its great importance in the country's economy and symbolizes abundance and prosperity, but is also found in regional heraldry.
