The Latvian coat of arms is a shield with a rising sun on a blue background in the upper part, a red lion on a silver background in the lower left, and a silver griffin on a red background in the lower right. The red lion on the Latvian coat of arms symbolizes Kurzeme and Zemgale (western and southwestern Latvia). The silver griffin symbolizes Vidzeme and Latgale (northeastern Latvia and southeastern Latvia). Despite Latvia being a republic, which city's coat of arms still features a crown?
