The national flag of India consists of a rectangular field with three horizontal stripes of equal width: the top one is "deep saffron," the middle one is white, and the bottom one is green.

Initially, the colors of the Indian flag were different and had other religious meanings: red for Hindus, green for Muslims, and white for other religions. In the center of the white stripe is an image of a wheel with 24 spokes, dark blue in color — symbolizing...

India General 3

Why are lions often depicted on coats of arms? The coat of arms features four Indian lions on a circular abacus. The fourth lion is located at the back and is hidden from view. The coat of arms symbolizes a nation that “is brave in courage, strong in body, wise in counsel, and terrifies its enemies.” The abacus is adorned with four animals — symbols of the four directions: the Lion — the north, the Elephant — the east, the Bull — the south, and the Horse — the west (only the Horse and the Bull are visible in the image). The abacus rests on a lotus, symbolizing the source of life. The national emblem of India is a replica of the Lion Capital of Sarnath (near Varanasi), erected in the 3rd century BCE by Emperor Ashoka at the site where Buddha proclaimed his message of peace and liberation, addressed to the four corners of the world. Below the abacus is the motto...
