Who comes up with the name of a state? After a period of internal conflict, the Kingdom of Lan Xang broke up into three kingdoms — Luang Prabang, Vientiane, and Champasak. In 1893, these three territories came under a French protectorate, were united, and named Laos. After gaining independence in 1953, a civil war began, during which the communist resistance, supported by the Soviet Union, fought against the monarchy, which later came under U.S. influence. After the end of the Vietnam War in 1975, the communist Pathet Lao ended the civil war. Until 1991, Laos depended on military and economic assistance...
