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Введение

Настоящая книга предназначена для изучающих английский язык на уровне В1. Основной целью является развитие навыков устной речи через знакомство с реальными диалоговыми ситуациями. Каждая глава представляет собой диалог, содержащий актуальные темы повседневного общения, сопровождаемый разбором ключевой лексики с переводом и примерами употребления, а также практическим упражнением для закрепления материала.

Структура книги позволяет последовательно изучать и применять лексику в контексте, что способствует формированию уверенности в общении на английском языке. Особое внимание уделено практическим аспектам коммуникации: умению задавать вопросы, отвечать на них, уточнять информацию, выражать своё мнение и вести беседу в различных бытовых и профессиональных ситуациях.

Данное пособие рассчитано на самостоятельное обучение и может использоваться в рамках групповых занятий. Материал ориентирован на формирование навыков, необходимых для повседневного общения, профессиональных контактов и путешествий.

Книга систематизирует основные темы, которые чаще всего встречаются в жизни изучающих язык, и предлагает методы активного освоения лексики и фраз, применимых сразу после изучения. Работа с диалогами и упражнениями способствует развитию речевых навыков, улучшению понимания на слух и подготовке к реальным коммуникативным ситуациям.
