In the national anthems of which countries are state borders mentioned? In the first verse of the “Patriotic Song of the Germans,” written by H. von Fallersleben in 1841, it is sung: “Germany, Germany above all, from the Meuse to the Memel, from the Adige to the Belt.” Today, the Meuse is a river in the Netherlands, the Memel is the city of Klaipėda, the Adige is a settlement in Austria, and the Belt is a strait controlled by Denmark. In the north, Germany borders Denmark; in the east — Poland and the Czech Republic; in the south — Austria and Switzerland; in the west — France, Luxembourg, Belgium, and the Netherlands. In total — 9 countries. What separated Germany into two states from August 13, 1961, to November 9, 1989?

On the flags of which countries can the color black be seen? The national flag of Germany consists of black, red, and yellow (gold) horizontal stripes, where black symbolizes the past (years of reaction), red — the blood of patriots, and the yellow (gold) stripe represents the sun of freedom and the future of the country. The colors of the German flag — black-red-gold — historically date back to 1813, the time of the struggle against Napoleon. At that time, German student volunteers of the “Free Corps” wore black cloaks embroidered with red trim and brass (yellow) buttons. If the German flag is rotated by 90 degrees, it can be confused with the flag of...

On the coats of arms of which countries can the image of an eagle be seen? The coat of arms of Germany features a yellow shield with a black single-headed eagle with bloodied claws, which symbolizes the strength and power of the state. During the Third Reich, by order of Hitler, the Prussian eagle on the coat of arms spread its wings. The main color of the flag was red with a white circle containing a black swastika inside. Previously, the coat of arms of the GDR depicted a hammer, symbolizing the working class, a wreath of wheat ears, symbolizing the peasantry, and...
