How were the attributes of sovereignty created? The flag of Canada consists of a red rectangular field with a white square

in the center, which features an eleven-pointed red maple leaf. The side stripes are identical in width, each being $\frac{1}{4}$ of the flag's length. This configuration of the flag is known as the «Canadian Pillar.» The number and arrangement of the points of the leaf were chosen after aerodynamic tunnel tests, which showed how the image on the flag was least distorted under strong winds. The flag of Canada was introduced only in 1965; before that, the flag was...
