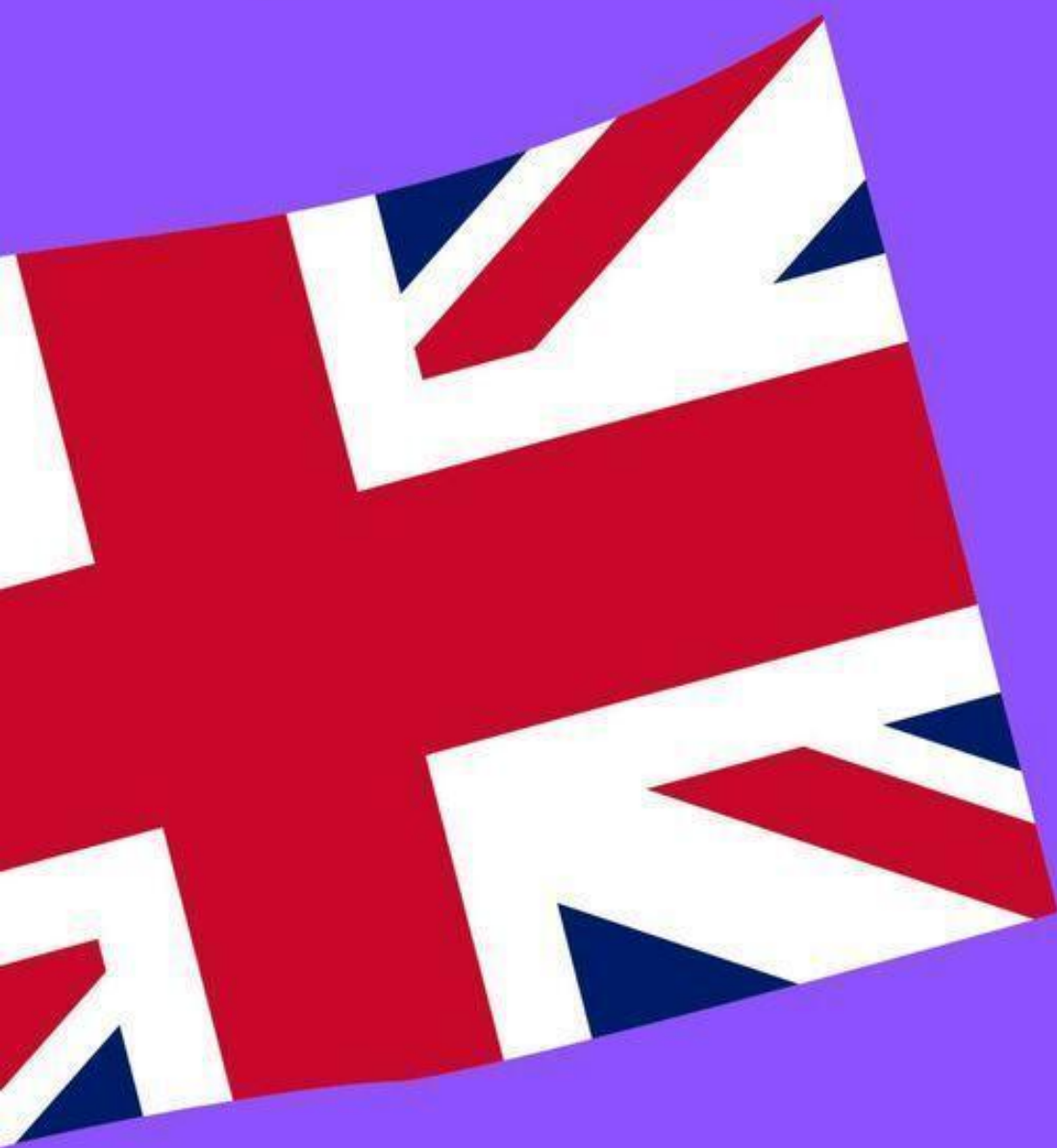

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Введение

Данный сборник текстов предназначен для учащихся уровня B1, изучающих английский язык. Его основная цель заключается в развитии навыков чтения, расширении активного словарного запаса и формировании способности выражать личные мысли на иностранном языке в письменной и устной форме.

Материалы построены вокруг повседневных и близких подросткам тем, что способствует лучшему пониманию содержания и повышает мотивацию к обучению. Такой формат позволяет не только понять содержание, но и активно применять изученные языковые элементы в собственной речи.

Структура пособия ориентирована на постепенное усложнение материала и развитие языковой уверенности учащихся. Особое внимание уделяется формированию навыков самостоятельного высказывания, что является важным этапом в изучении иностранного языка на среднем уровне.
