Всё включено: аудирование, чтение, грамматика, письмо и ключи для самопроверки. Три уровня сложности и полное погружение в материал. Соответствует ФГОС и демоверсии ВПР.

О пособии

Настоящее пособие представляет собой сборник из 135 тренировочных вариантов для подготовки к Всероссийской проверочной работе (ВПР) по английскому языку в 6 классе. Издание полностью соответствует актуальной демоверсии ВПР 2026 года и требованиям Федерального государственного образовательного стандарта основного общего образования (ФГОС ООО).

Структура каждого варианта включает четыре раздела: аудирование, чтение, грамматика и письмо, что позволяет комплексно отработать все виды речевой деятельности в формате экзамена.

Пособие охватывает все темы кодификатора для 6 класса: видо-временные формы глагола (Present Simple, Present Continuous, Present Perfect, Past Simple, Past Continuous, Past Perfect, Future Simple, be going to), страдательный залог, условные предложения (нулевой, первый, второй и третий типы), модальные глаголы (can, could, must, have to, may,

might, will be able to), придаточные времени, артикли, местоимения, степени сравнения прилагательных, герундий и инфинитив, исчисляемые и неисчисляемые существительные (some, any, too, enough), а также косвенную речь.

Особое внимание уделяется страноведческому материалу. Тексты для аудирования и чтения знакомят учащихся с географией, историей, культурой, традициями и выдающимися личностями Великобритании, США, Австралии и других англоязычных стран. Темы текстов вызывают познавательный интерес у школьников: от кулинарных традиций и знаменитых шеф-поваров до научных открытий, технологий будущего, экологических проблем и исторических личностей.

Задания сгруппированы по принципу уровневой дифференциации: варианты 1–60 — базовый уровень, 61–120 — повышенный, 121–135 — репетиционный экзамен.

Аудиоскрипты интегрированы в текст, что позволяет выполнять задания на восприятие речи на слух без использования дополнительных аудиоматериалов. Ключи для самопроверки приведены в конце пособия.

Издание адресовано учащимся 6 классов, учителям, репетиторам и родителям для систематической подготовки к ВПР как в школе, так и при самостоятельных занятиях.

Рекомендуемый график работы — 15 вариантов в месяц с сентября по май, что обеспечивает равномерное распределение нагрузки и исключает необходимость интенсивной под-

готовки непосредственно перед экзаменом.

Life in an English village

Many people dream of living in a quiet place, far from the noise of big cities. In England, about nine million people live in villages. Village life is very different from city life, and it has both advantages and disadvantages.

One of the best things about living in a village is the community. In a village, everybody knows everybody. People say hello to each other in the street, and neighbours often help each other. For example, if someone is ill, neighbours bring them food or drive them to the doctor. In big cities, many people do not even know the names of the people who live next door.

Another advantage is the environment. Villages are usually surrounded by fields, forests or hills. The air is clean and fresh. Children can play outside safely. You can hear birds singing in the morning instead of car horns and police sirens. Many people say they sleep better in a village because it is so quiet at night.

However, there are also problems. Public transport in villages is often very poor. Buses come only two or three times a day, and there is no underground or tram. This means that families usually need a car. Teenagers often complain that there is nothing to do. There are no cinemas, shopping centres or night clubs. To go to a concert or a big shop, people must drive to the nearest town, which might be thirty or forty minutes away.

There is also the question of work. Most jobs are in cities. People who live in villages often have to travel a long distance to work. This takes time and costs money. Some people work from home using the internet, but this is not possible for everyone.

So, where is it better to live? The answer depends on your personality and lifestyle. If you love peace and nature, a village is perfect. If you need excitement and opportunities, a big city might be better for you.

Life in the American Deep South

When people think of the United States, they often imagine New York or Los Angeles. But there is another America – the rural Deep South. This region includes states like Alabama, Mississippi, Georgia and Louisiana. Life there is very different from big cities.

One of the first things you notice is the heat. Summers are long, hot and humid. Temperatures often reach 35 degrees or more. People try to stay inside during the afternoon. Many houses have large porches where families sit in the evenings when it gets cooler. Air conditioning is not a luxury – it is necessary.

The Deep South is famous for its hospitality. Southerners are

known for being very friendly. Strangers say 'hello' to you in the street. Neighbours bring food when someone moves in. If your car breaks down, someone will almost certainly stop to help.

This is something that surprises visitors from the north. Food is very important in the South. Traditional dishes include fried chicken, biscuits (which are like savoury scones), okra and pecan pie. Many families grow vegetables in their gardens. Tomatoes, beans and corn are very common. On Sundays, families often have a big lunch after church. This meal can last for two hours.

However, living in the countryside of the South has challenges. Public transport is almost non-existent. You must have a car to go anywhere – to school, work or the shops. The nearest hospital can be fifty kilometres away. Internet connection can be slow in very remote areas. Young people often complain that there is nothing exciting to do.

Another problem is work. Traditional industries like farming and textiles have declined. Many young people move to cities like Atlanta or Houston to find jobs. Some towns have lost half their population in the last thirty years. The people who stay often work in tourism, healthcare or education.

Despite these problems, many Southerners love where they live. They value the slow pace of life, the strong communities and the beautiful nature. For them, the Deep South is not just a place – it is home.

The best coach company in London

Millions of people travel between London and other British cities every day. One of the most popular ways is by coach.

Coaches are large buses that travel long distances. They are cheaper than trains and often more comfortable than people expect. The coach station in London is called Victoria Coach Station. It is near Victoria railway station but do not confuse them. From here, coaches leave for cities like Manchester, Birmingham, Bristol and even Edinburgh in Scotland. Every day, more than one thousand coaches come and go.

There are several coach companies in the UK. The largest and most famous is National Express. It has a yellow and blue logo. You can book tickets online or at the station. The prices are lower if you book early. A ticket from London to Manchester can cost

ten pounds if you book two weeks before. On the day of travel, the same ticket can cost forty pounds.

Another good company is Megabus. Megabus is cheaper than National Express but it has fewer departures. Some Megabus tickets cost only one pound if you book very early. However, Megabus coaches are sometimes less comfortable. The seats are smaller and there is less leg room.

Both companies offer free Wi-Fi and toilets on board. You can charge your phone using a USB socket. Some coaches have tables and reading lights. The journey from London to Manchester takes about four and a half hours. That is longer than the train, which takes two hours, but the coach is much cheaper.

What is the best company? It depends on what you need. If you want the lowest price, choose Megabus. If you want more departures and better comfort, choose National Express. You should also check customer reviews online. Some companies have better drivers and cleaner toilets than others. When you travel by coach, you should arrive thirty minutes before departure. You should keep your ticket on your phone or printed. You should not be late because the coach never waits. Many people also bring a pillow and a bottle of water for the journey.

So, next time you travel from London to another city, consider the coach. It is slower than the train but your wallet thanks you.

Cycle safety rules in London

Cycling in London is becoming more and more popular. Every day, thousands of people travel by bike. It is often faster than the bus and cheaper than the tube. However, London streets are busy. Cyclists should follow important safety rules.

The first rule is to wear a helmet. A helmet protects your head. If you fall off your bike, a helmet can save your life. Some cyclists think helmets are uncomfortable. But a helmet is better than a hospital visit. You should also wear bright clothes. Drivers can see bright colours better, especially in the dark or in rain.

The second rule is about lights. By law, every bike in the UK must have a white light at the front and a red light at the back. You must also have a red reflector at the back. These lights are necessary when you cycle between sunset and sunrise. Many

accidents happen because drivers do not see cyclists without lights.

The third rule is to use cycle lanes. London has many blue painted cycle lanes on the roads. Some are on the pavement. The best cycle lanes are called Cycle Superhighways. They are wider than normal cycle lanes. They have their own traffic lights. The Superhighways are safer than cycling on ordinary roads.

The fourth rule is to be careful at junctions. Most bike accidents happen at junctions, not on straight roads. You should always look left and right before crossing. You should never cycle through the red traffic light. Some cyclists break this rule, but it is dangerous. A car can appear very fast.

The fifth rule is to signal. Before you turn left or right, you should put your arm out. This tells drivers what you are going to do. Many cyclists do not signal. That is a mistake. Drivers cannot read your mind. The number of bike accidents in London is now lower than ten years ago. The city is building more cycle lanes every year. But accidents still happen.

In 2023, there were more than four thousand cycling accidents in London. That is a smaller number than in 2013. So, things are getting better. Cycling is a wonderful way to travel. It is good for your health and good for the environment. Just remember the rules. Wear a helmet, use lights, stay in cycle lanes, be careful at junctions and always signal.

The hidden dangers of country life

When people think of the countryside, they imagine fresh air, green fields and quiet roads. Many families move from cities to villages because they want a better life for their children. However, living in the country has psychological dangers that people do not expect. These dangers are not snakes or spiders only. They are dangers to your mind.

A teenager walking home alone can feel very scared. Every sound – a branch breaking, an animal moving – seems dangerous. The dark is scarier in the country than in the city.

Life in a cottage

When people imagine a perfect English home, they often think of a cottage. A cottage is a small house, usually old, with thick walls and a garden full of flowers. Many cottages have thatched roofs. Life in a British castle

When you think of a British castle, you probably imagine kings, queens, knights and battles. Castles look exciting in films. But what is it really like to live in a castle today?

Some people in Britain still live in castles. They are usually very rich families who have owned the castle for hundreds of years.

How to balance school, hobbies, friends and housework

Do you feel that there are not enough hours in the day? You go to school, do homework, see your friends and go to hobby clubs. And then your parents want you to clean your room too! Many teenagers have this problem. The good news is that you can do everything. You just need a plan.

The first rule is to stop thinking that cleaning takes hours. Many people believe that. They are wrong. You can do small cleaning tasks in five or ten minutes. For example, making your bed takes two minutes. Putting dirty clothes in the basket takes one minute. Wiping your desk takes three minutes. These small tasks do not steal your time. They fit between bigger activities.

The second rule is to remember the 'ten minute rule'. Every day, spend exactly ten minutes cleaning your room. Set a timer on your phone. When the timer rings, you stop. Do not do more. Do not do less. Just ten minutes. You will be surprised how much

you can clean in ten minutes. Your room will never become very messy because you clean it every day.

The third rule is to understand what 'clean enough' means. Your room does not need to look like a museum. It needs to be tidy enough for you to find things and for your family not to complain. You do not need to clean under your bed every day. Once a month is fine. You do not need to organise your books by colour. That is nice but not necessary.

The fourth rule is to use waiting time. What do you do when you wait for dinner? What do you do when you wait for your friend to call? You can clean something. Put away three things from your floor. That takes one minute. These small moments add up. People who use waiting time have cleaner rooms than people who do not.

The fifth rule is to ask for help. You cannot clean the whole house alone. That is your parents' job too. You should clean your own room and maybe help with the dishes. The rest is not your responsibility. Do not feel guilty. You need time for homework, hobbies and friends. Your parents understand this. They were teenagers once.

Some teenagers feel that cleaning is boring. They are right. Cleaning is not as fun as playing football or watching a film. But you do not need to love cleaning. You just need to do a little bit every day. Think of it like brushing your teeth. You do not love it, but you do it because it is good for you.

The best news is the weekend. If you clean for ten minutes

every day from Monday to Friday, your weekend is free. You do not need to spend Saturday morning cleaning. Your room is already tidy. You can sleep longer or go out with friends. That is the best reward.

So, start today. Set a timer. Clean for ten minutes. See what happens. I know you can do it.

Why do noodles get soft and eggs get hard?

Do you know why pasta becomes soft when you cook it, but

an egg becomes hard? The answer is in the science of proteins and gluten. These are special molecules that change when you heat them.

Pasta is made from flour and water. Flour contains gluten, which is a type of protein. When you put pasta in hot water, the water goes inside the pasta. Can you find food that looks like foam or caviar but tastes like fruit juice? This is molecular gastronomy. It is a modern style of cooking that uses science to create amazing dishes.

Many children hear their parents say: 'Don't eat after 6 pm or you will get fat!' But is this really true?

The answer is more complicated than you might think. Scientists have studied this question and they found no evidence that eating after 6 pm causes weight gain. The real problem is not the time when you eat. The problem is what and how much you eat. If you eat a big meal right before bed, your body may not digest it well. Why does popcorn pop and soup explode in the microwave?

Popcorn and soup are two very different foods, but they both use the same scientific principle – water turning into steam. When water heats up, it changes from liquid to gas. This is called steam. Steam takes up much more space than water. This expansion is what makes popcorn pop and soup explode.

Popcorn kernels have a hard outer shell. Inside each kernel, there is a small amount of water. When you heat popcorn, the water inside turns into steam. The steam tries to escape, but the hard shell traps it. The pressure builds up. When the pressure becomes too high, the kernel explodes. The inside of the kernel turns inside out and becomes the fluffy popcorn we eat.

Soup in the microwave works in a similar way. When you heat soup, the water inside heats up and turns into steam. But soup has fat and other ingredients. These ingredients can trap the steam. When the pressure becomes too high, the soup erupts. This is

why soup sometimes explodes in the microwave.

Scientists have studied these phenomena for many years. They discovered that the size of the container and the amount of water are very important. Popcorn kernels must have the right amount of water inside. If a kernel has too little water, it will not pop. If it has too much water, it will not pop either. For soup, you must stir it before heating. This helps the heat spread evenly and prevents explosions.
