Amazing Altai Republic. Kaleidoscope of Questions. General Information

Altai Republic General 1 (regional territory)

What determines the geopolitical significance of a region?
Which statement is false?

1. The Altai Republic is the only region of Russia that borders three foreign countries simultaneously: China, Mongolia, and Kazakhstan. On the Ukok Plateau, the interests of the four countries intersect at a single point.

2. The length of the border between the Altai Republic and China is only 55 km — this is the shortest section of the border between the Russian Federation and the People's Republic of China.

3. Belukha Mountain is located at an equal distance from three oceans — the Atlantic, Indian and Pacific, and is the geographic center of the Eurasian continent. The border between Russia and Kazakhstan runs through Mount Belukha in the Altai Republic.

4. In 1937, the Altai Krai was formed with its center in the city of Barnaul. It included the Oirot Autonomous Oblast, which separated in 1992 and became an independent subject of the Russian Federation — the Altai Republic.

5. The Trans-Siberian Highway passes through the picturesque territories of three Russian regions — Novosibirsk Oblast, Altai Krai, and the Altai Republic — and connects Russia with Mongolia and China.

Altai Republic General 2 (flag symbols)

What is the philosophy behind the 1/4 and 1/25 stripe ratio on the flag? Which statement is incorrect?

1. The white background of the flag of the Altai Republic symbolizes eternity, purity of thoughts and snow-capped mountain peaks.

2. The two blue stripes at the bottom of the flag represent the two main rivers of the region, the Katun and the Biya, which, when they merge, give rise to the Ob River.

3. The color blue in Altai culture is associated with the «Eternal Blue Sky» (Tengri) — the ancient spiritual guide of nomads.

4. The loaded camel on the Altai flag recalls the passage of trade routes through the region.

5. The flag of the Altai Republic looks minimalistic so as not to disturb the mountain landscape with unnecessary details.

Altai Republic General 3

(emblem of the coat of arms)

Altai Republic General 4

(toponymy, etymology of names)
